1. The Government of the Philippines (hereinafter called “Borrower”) has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) (the “Bank”) in the form of a loan (hereinafter called “Loan”) toward the cost of the Cebu Bus Rapid Transit Project. The Department of Transportation (DOTr), an implementing agency or the Client, intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this Loan to eligible payments under the contract for which this Request for Proposals (RFP) is issued. Payments by the Bank will be made only at the request of the DOTC and upon approval by the Bank and will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the Loan Agreement. The Loan Agreement prohibits a withdrawal from the Loan Account for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of the Bank, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than the Government of the Philippines shall derive any rights from the Loan Agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the loan.
2. The Client now invites proposals to provide the following consulting services (hereinafter called “Services”): *Social Management Consultant for the Cebu Bus Rapid Transit System Project*. More details on the Services are provided in the Terms of Reference (Section 7).
3. This RFP has been addressed to the following shortlisted Consultants:

 - e) Monkey Forest Consulting, Ltd. in association with Pacific Strategies and Assessments.
