



In line with DOTC's aim of providing the people with a Convenient, Affordable, Reliable, Efficient and Safe transport system, the Department is inviting qualified bidders to participate in the OPEN and TRANSPARENT process for the procurement of the following project:

INVITATION FOR BID

CAPACITY ENHANCEMENT OF MASS TRANSIT SYSTEMS IN METRO MANILA - PROCUREMENT OF TRACKWORK, ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL SYSTEMS AND INTEGRATION WITH EXISTING SYSTEMS FOR LRT LINE 2 PROJECT



- 1** The Government of the Republic of the Philippines has received a loan from the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) towards the cost of the Capacity Enhancement of Mass Transit Systems in Metro Manila. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this loan will be applied to eligible payments under the Contract for Procurement of Trackwork, Electrical and Mechanical (E&M) Systems and Integration with Existing Systems for Light Rail Transit (LRT) Line 2 – East (Masinag) Extension Project (“the Project”).
- 2** Bidding will be conducted through procedures in accordance with the applicable Guidelines for Procurement under Japanese ODA Loans, and is open to all Bidders from eligible source countries, as follows:
 - a. Japan in the case of the prime contractor;
 - b. All countries and areas in the case of the sub-contractor(s); and
 - c. In case where the prime contractor is a joint venture, such joint venture will be eligible provided that the nationality of the lead partner is Japanese, that the nationality of the other partners is Japanese and/or Filipino and that the total share of work of Japanese partners in the joint venture is more than fifty percent (50%) of the contract amount.
- 3** The Department of Transportation and Communications (DOTC) now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the Design-Build of Trackwork and E&M Systems comprising of the following: a) Power Supply System; b) Telecommunications System; c) Overhead Catenary System; d) Signaling; e) Operations Control Center; and f) Automatic Fare Collection System (by Nominated Subcontractor). The works include designs, manufacture, test, delivery, storage, installation, interface/integration of both LRT Line 2 Systems, including testing, commissioning and training.
- 4** The Bidder shall demonstrate that it possesses the technical capacity and capability in respect of Work Method, Equipment and Personnel to meet the requirements specified in the Bidding Documents. Eligible Bidders must meet the eligibility criteria on a pass/fail basis stated in the Evaluation and Qualification Criteria of the Bidding Documents.
- 5** International Competitive Bidding will be conducted in accordance with JICA’s “Single-Stage (Without Prequalification)” Bidding Procedure.
- 6** The provisions in the Instructions to Bidders (ITB) and in the General Conditions of Contract are the provisions of the Standard Bidding Documents under Japanese ODA Loans for the Procurement of Electrical and Mechanical Plant, and for Building and Engineering Works, Designed by the Contractor (Trial Version) issued by JICA in July 2015.
- 7** A complete set of the Bidding Documents may be purchased by interested Bidders upon submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Forty Five Thousand Pesos (PHP 45,000.00) during office hours from 11 December 2015 to 26 February 2016 at Unit 22, 2nd Floor, The Columbia Tower, Ortigas Avenue, Barangay Wack-Wack, Mandaluyong City, Philippines.
- 8** Bidding Documents may be downloaded free of charge from the website of the DOTC at www.dotc.gov.ph provided that the Bidders shall pay the non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids. Bidders may also view and download the Bidding Documents from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement Systems (PhilGEPS) at www.philgeps.gov.ph provided that bidders register with PhilGEPS.
- 9** A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on 22 December 2015, 10:30 AM at the DOTC Conference Room, 16th Floor, The Columbia Tower, Ortigas Avenue, Barangay Wack-Wack, Mandaluyong City, Philippines which shall be open to all interested parties including those which have not purchased the Bidding Documents.
- 10** Bids must be delivered to the address shown below on or before 26 February 2016, 10:30 AM and must be accompanied by a Bid Security in accordance with Clause 21.1 of the ITB Data Sheet.
