The Refurbishment of Diesel Multiple Units (DMUs) entails the restoration and repair of nine (9) DMUs. Completion of the works is required within twenty four (24) months upon issuance of NTP.

The Refurbishment of Diesel Electric Locomotives (DELs) of the PNR entails the overhaul and upgrading of DEL Nos. 916, 917 and 922. Completion of the works is required within twenty-four (24) months upon issuance of NTP.

The project entails the supply and delivery of Capital Spare Parts for the DMUs of the PNR. Completion of the delivery is required within nine (9) months upon issuance of NTP.

▶ Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criteria as specified in the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (RIRR) of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".

▶ Bidders should have completed, within ten (10) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project.

▶ The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II, Instructions to Bidders (ITB). Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183 and subject to Commonwealth Act 138.

▶ Interested bidders may obtain further information from the DOTC and inspect the Bidding Documents at Unit 22, 2nd Floor, The Columbia Tower, Ortigas Avenue, Brgy. Wack-Wack, Mandaluyong City from Mondays to Fridays, 8:00AM to 5:00PM.

▶ A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by interested bidders from 30 July 2015 until the deadline for the submission of bids from the address above and upon payment of a non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents. It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that bidders shall pay the fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

▶ All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 18.

▶ The DOTC reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.

▶ Bid opening shall immediately follow after the deadline for submission of bids on the same date at the DOTC Conference Room, 16th Floor, the Columbia Tower, Ortigas Ave., Brgy. Wack-Wack, Mandaluyong City. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address given above. Late bids shall not be accepted.
