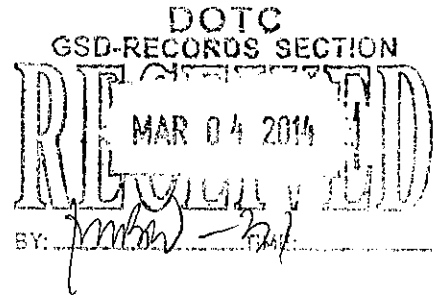




Dear Director Quiogue:
