Subject : AMENDMENTS TO THE DEPARTMENT ORDER NO. 2014-010

Date : 27 APRIL 2015

Pursuant to Section 7 of Republic Act No. 9993, there is a need to increase the number of flag rank positions in the Philippine Coast Guard to cope with the increasing challenges in maritime law and the expansion of the PCG as the primary agency in the enforcement of maritime laws. Certain provisions of Department Order No. 2014-010 dated 02 September 2014 as hereinafter cited shall now be amended and read as follows:

1. Para IV on Functional Responsibilities particularly subparagraphs (b), (c) and (e) shall be amended as follows:

IV. FUNCTIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Headquarters, Philippine Coast Guard

xxx

(b) The Chief of Coast Guard Staff shall carry the rank of Rear Admiral (O-8) in the table of organization position.

c) The Central Staff - shall advise the Commandant in the formulation of policies pertaining to Human Resource, Intelligence, Operations, Logistics, International Affairs, Comptrollership, Community Relations, Maritime Safety Services, Marine Environmental Protection Ships and Ships Repair, Weapons, Communications, Electronics Information Systems, Coast Guard Education and Training and Technical Services.

The Deputy of Coast Guard Staff for Human Resource, Deputy Coast Guard Staff for Operations, Deputy Coast Guard Staff for International Affairs, Deputy Coast Guard Staff for Comptrollership and Deputy Coast Guard Staff for Technical Services shall occupy the rank of Commodore (O-7) in the table of organization position.

e)The Bids and Awards Committee - shall undertake all procurement activities of the Philippine Coast Guard in accordance with existing rules, regulations, orders and circulars of the DOTC.

The Chairman of the Bids and Awards Committee shall be the third ranking officer of the Headquarters, PCG.

2. Para IV subpara 2 (a) shall be amended as follows:

2. Functional Commands (FCs)

xxx

a) **The Maritime Safety Services Command (MSSC)** - shall assist the Commandant, PCG xxx.

xxx

The Commander, Maritime Safety Services Command shall carry the rank of Vice Admiral (O-9) in the table of organization position.

The Commander, Coast Guard SAR Group shall carry the rank Commodore (O-7) in the table of organization position and shall at the same time, act as the Deputy Commander, MSSC.

3. Paragraph IV subpara 2 (b) shall be amended as follows:

b) **The Maritime Security and Law Enforcement Command (MARSLEC)** - shall be xxx

xxx

The Commander, Coast Guard Intelligence Force shall carry the rank of Commodore (O-7) in the table of organization position and shall at the same time, act as the Deputy Commander, MARSLEC. The Commander of CG K-9, CG Anti-Terrorist Unit and the Sea Marshall Group shall carry the rank of Captain (O-6) in the table of organization position.

4. Paragraph IV subpara 4 (a) shall be amended as follows:

a) **The Coast Guard Education and Training Command** - shall provide for the development of professionally competent coastguardsmen xxx

xxx

The Deputy Commander, CGETC shall carry the rank of COMMO (O-7) in the table of organization position.

5. Paragraph IV subpara 4(b) shall be amended as follows:

b) **The Coast Guard Internal Affairs Service** - shall xxx

xxx

The Commander, Coast Guard Internal Affairs Service shall carry the rank of Rear Admiral (O-8) in the table of organization position.

6. Paragraph IV subpara 4(c) shall be amended as follows:

c) The **Coast Guard Logistics Service (CGLOGS)** – shall be activated in the PCG Command. The Unit shall provide for the planning, procurement, distribution, supply management and facility establishment and maintenance of PCG resources and other assets thereof after thorough deliberation and identification of necessary development and modernization of the PCG.

The Commander, Coast Guard Logistics Service shall carry the rank of Commodore (O-7).

Under the CGLOGS is the **Coast Guard Procurement Service (CGPROC)**, the unit which shall be primarily responsible in the procurement of material and services needed for the PCG in accordance with R.A. 9184, and existing policies and procedures.

7. Paragraph V Subpara 5 shall be amended as follows:

The **Coast Guard Fleet** – shall xxx
xxx

The Commander, Fleet Command shall carry the rank of Vice Admiral (O-9) in the table of organization position.

The Deputy Commander, CG FLEET shall carry the rank of Commodore (O-7) in the table of organization position.

The **Coast Guard Ready Force** – shall xxx

The Commander, Coast Guard Ready Force shall carry the rank of Commodore (O-7) in the table of organization position.

The **Coast Guard Air Group** – shall xxx

The Commander, Coast Guard Air Group shall carry the rank of Commodore (O-7) in the table of organization position.

The **Coast Guard Weapons, Communications, Electronics, Information Systems Service** – shall xxx

The Commander, Coast Guard Weapons, Communications, Electronics, Information Systems Command shall carry the rank of Rear Admiral (O-8) in the table of organization position.

8. Paragraph VI shall be amended as follow:

VI. AMENDMENT CLAUSE

Amendments of the provisions of this Department Order shall be made every five (5) years or earlier, as deemed necessary.

9. Paragraph VII shall be amended as follow:

VII. REPEALING CLAUSE

All issuances and directives that are inconsistent herewith are deemed repealed, superseded, or amended accordingly.

10. Paragraph VIII shall read as follow:

VIII. EFFECTIVITY

This Order modifies Department Order No. 2014-010 accordingly, upon signing.

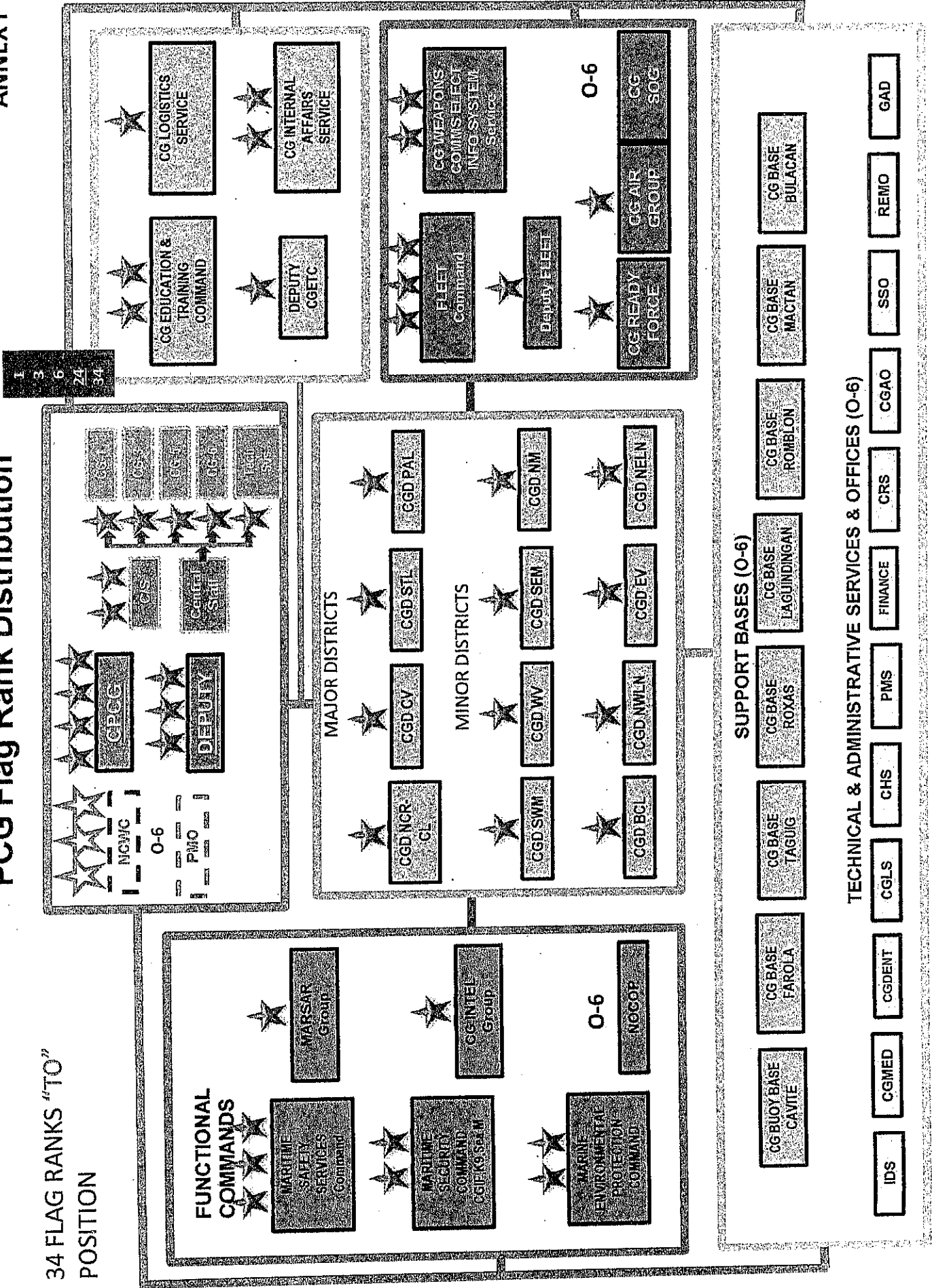


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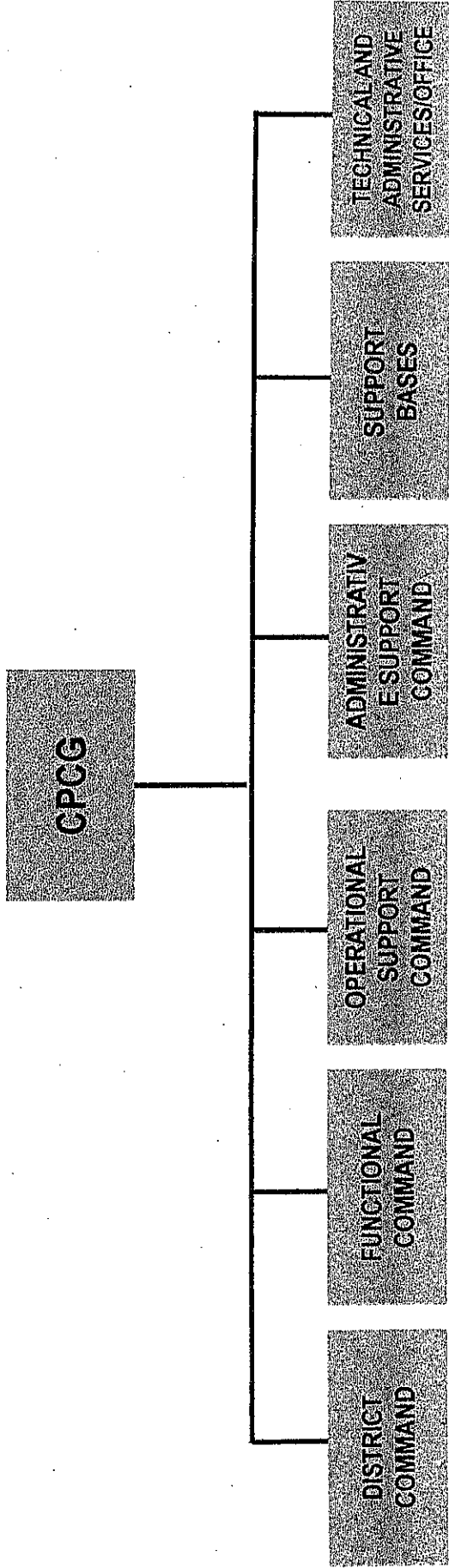

34 FLAG RANKS "TO" POSITION



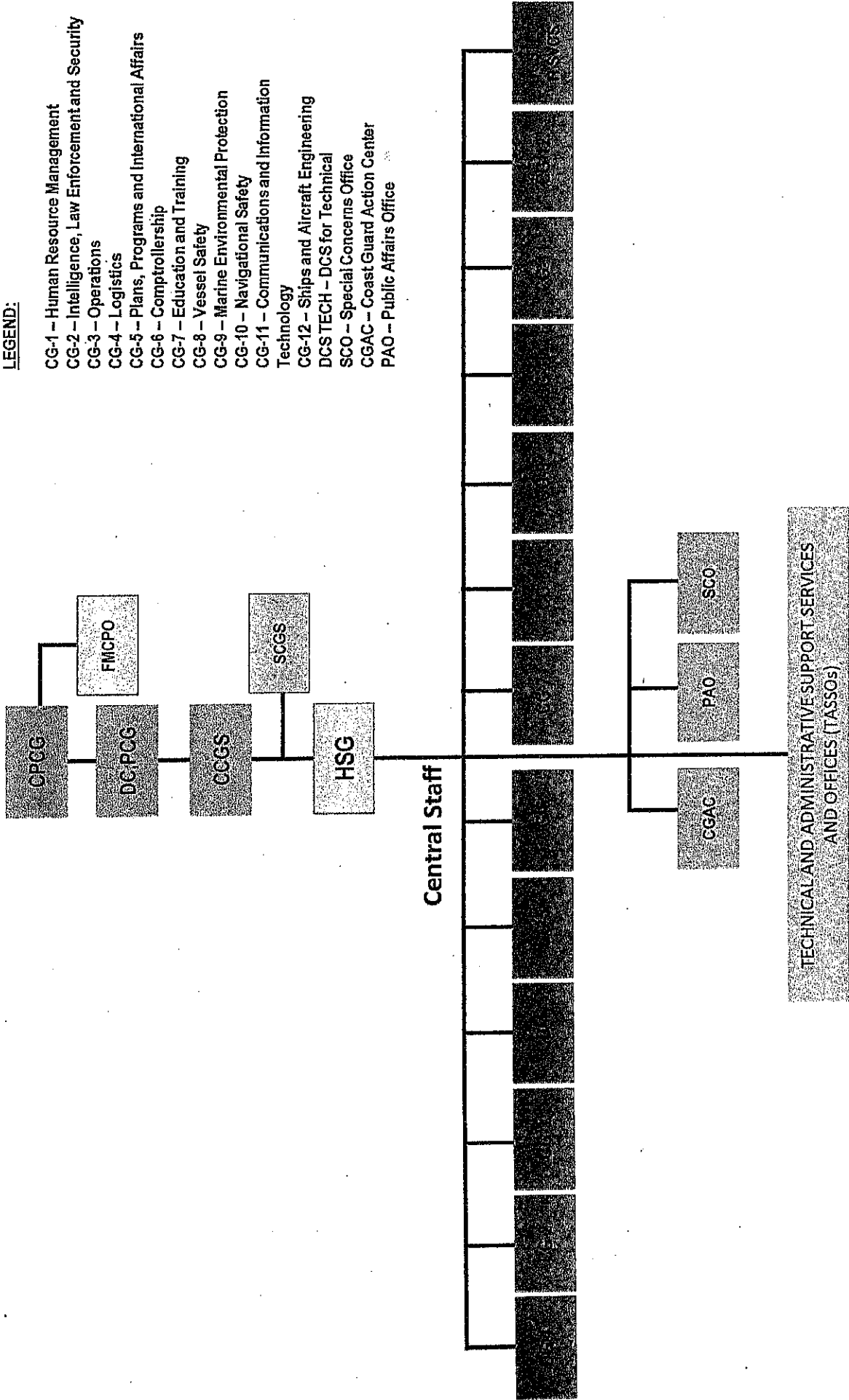
PCG COMMAND STRUCTURE



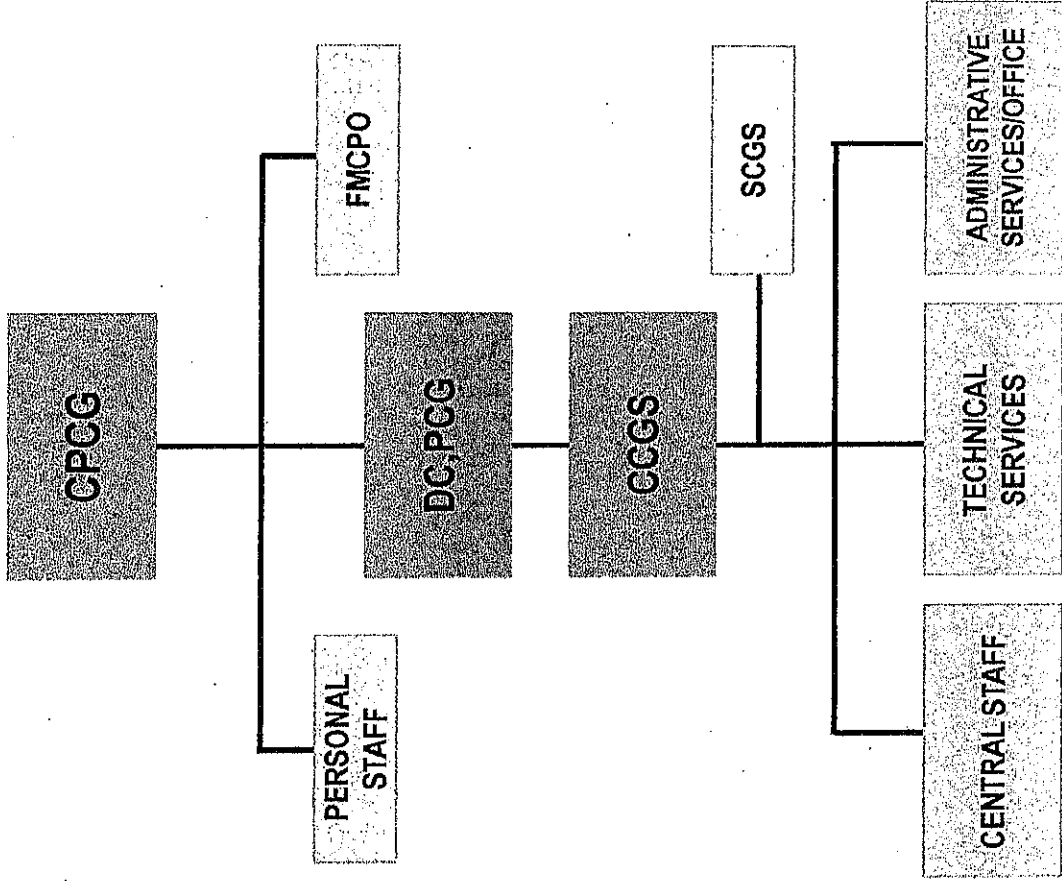
HPCG ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

HPCG ORGANIZATIONAL SET-UP



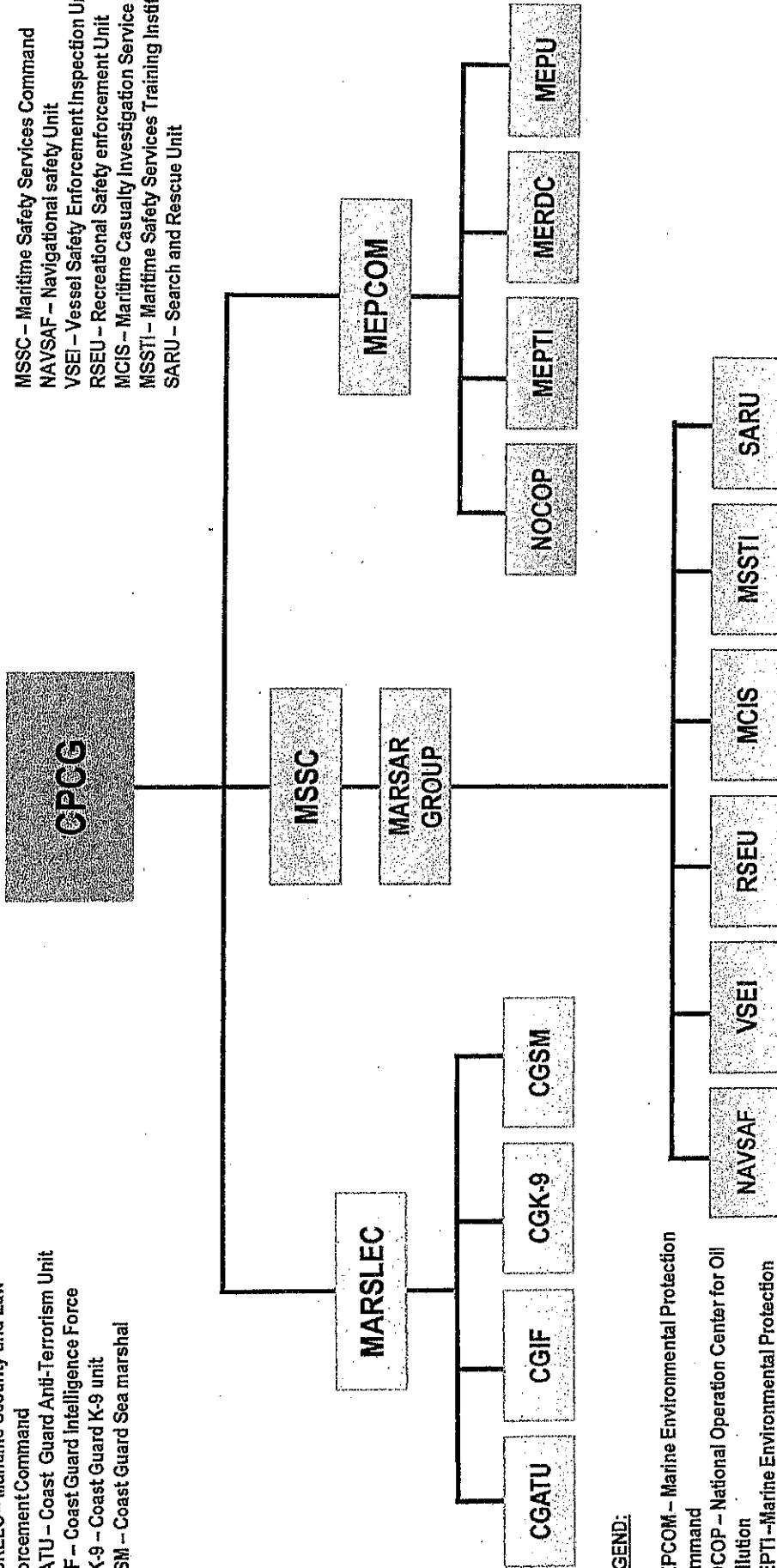

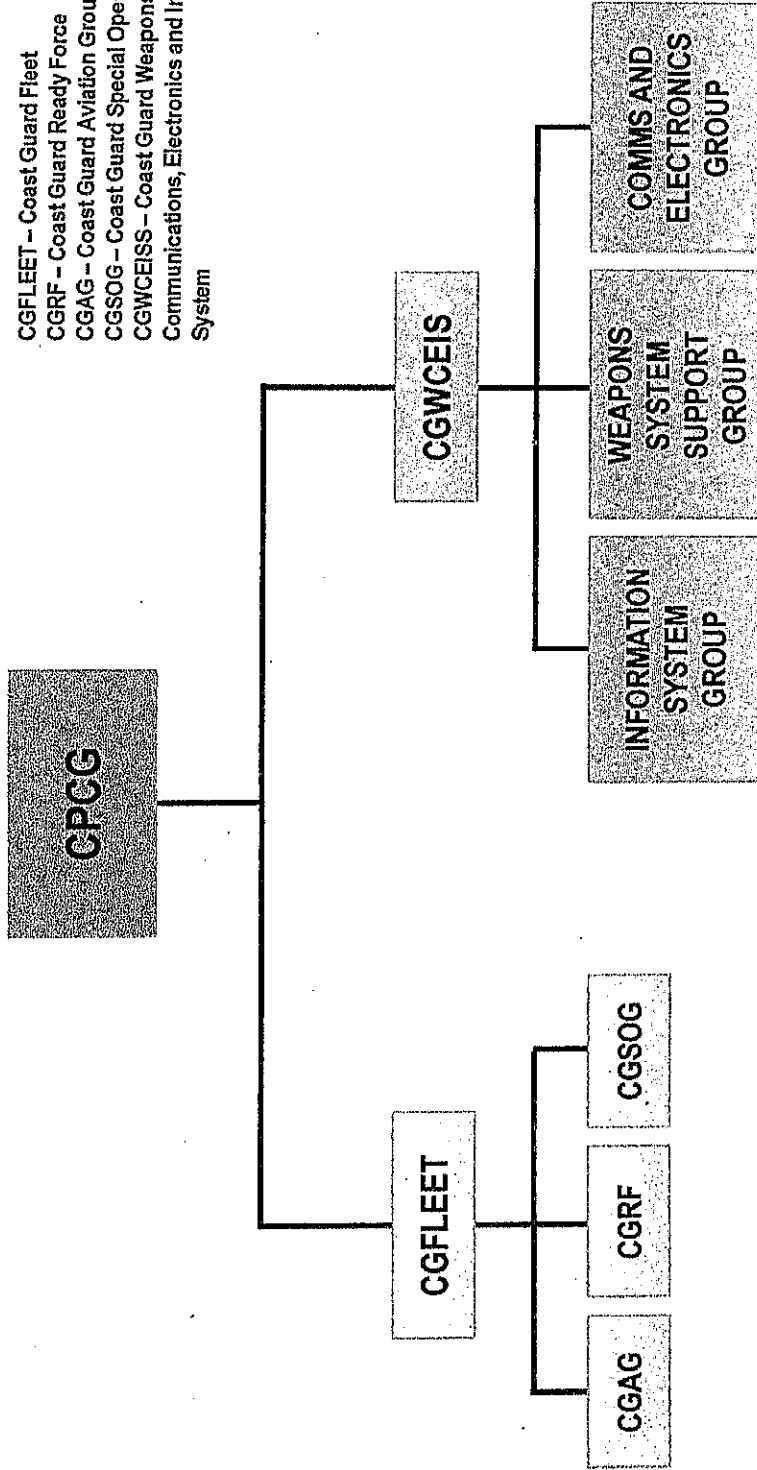

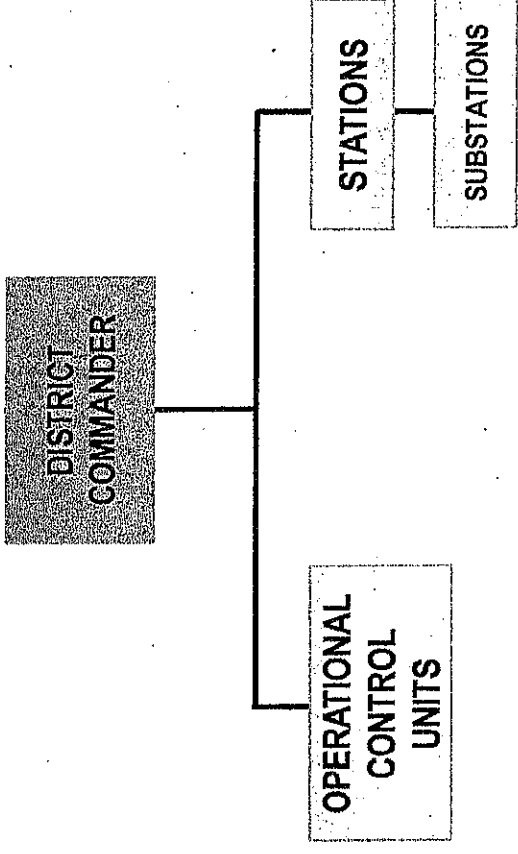

COAST GUARD DISTRICT ORGANIZATIONAL CHART



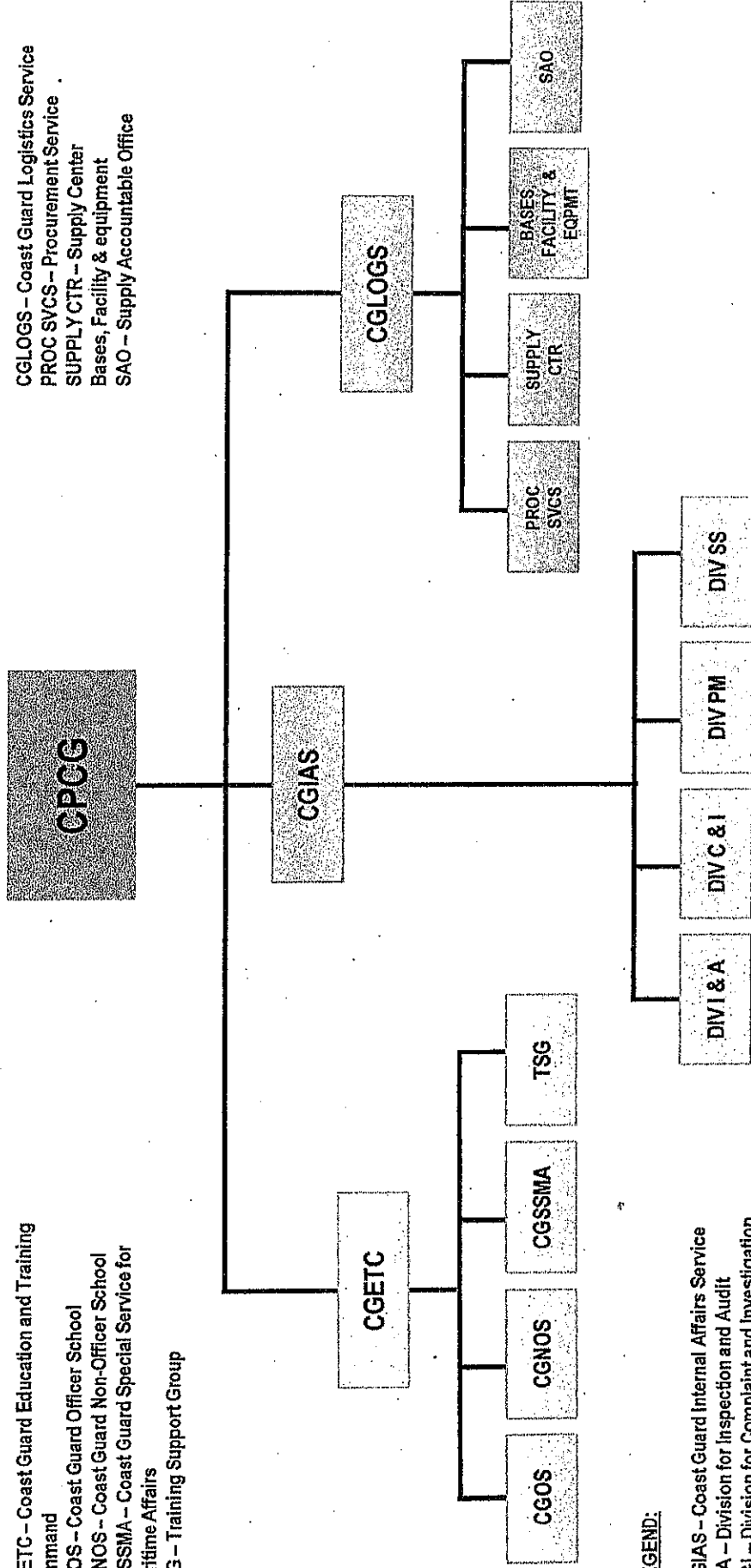

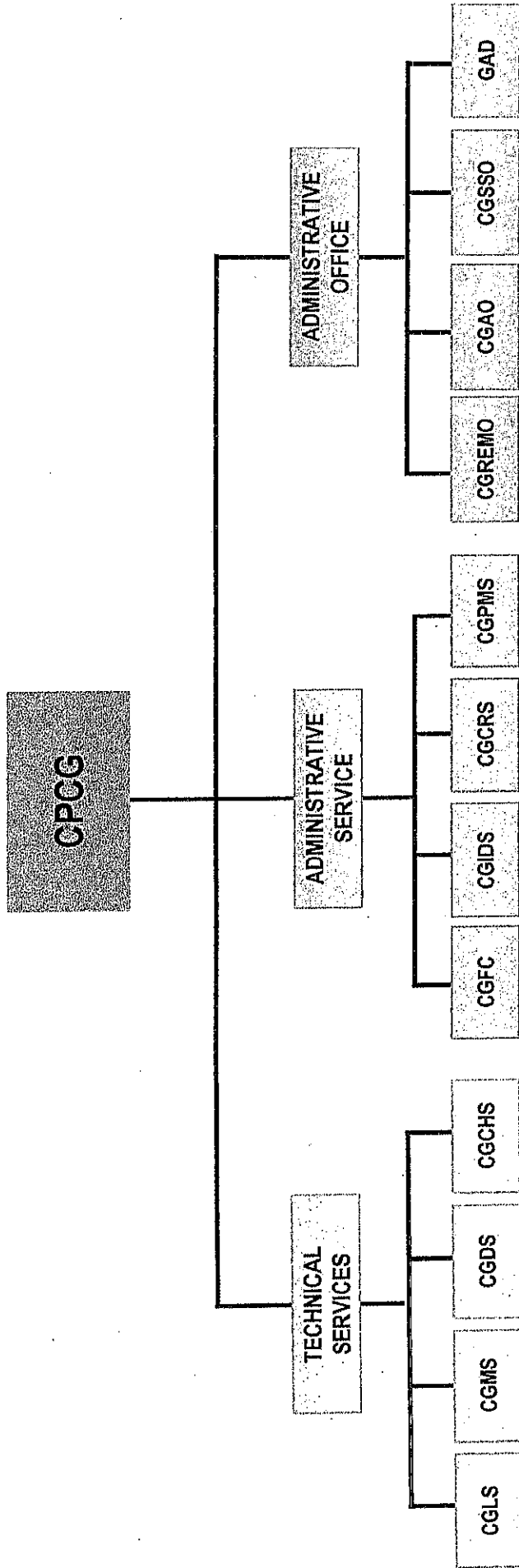
